Traditional Students

(Graduated from high school within last 5 years)

Beginning Spring 2009, students need to apply for Admissions online. If you cannot apply online, you can print off an application by going to the Admissions website.

To begin the application process:

Go to: <http://www.purdue.edu/Purdue/admissions/>

- Click on **apply online**. Select **Click Here to Apply Online** (If it is your first time on the site you will need to create a login)
- When applying to a Statewide Site, go to the bottom of the page under **College of Technology Statewide Students** and click on the appropriate application.
- Note: You may begin the process and return to complete the application at another time.

To finish the application process:

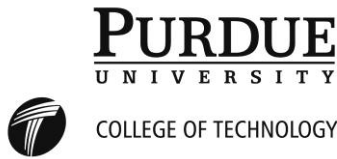
- Submit application online.
- The non-refundable application fee of \$30.00 must be paid online (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover credit cards are accepted).
- SAT or ACT scores are required for all beginning students and must be mailed to Purdue Admissions Office. Application will remain incomplete until received.
- Mail your official High School transcript to Purdue Admissions in West Lafayette.
- All Students **MUST** have a Guidance Counselor Form completed by their Guidance Counselor and submitted to Admissions. A link will be provided after you submit your application. This cannot be done electronically. Application will remain incomplete until received.

Non-traditional Student

(Students who graduated from high school 5 years or longer)

- Click on **apply online**
- Select **Click Here to Apply Online** (if it is your first time on the site you will need to create a login)
- When applying to a Statewide Site, go to the bottom of the page under **College of Technology Statewide Students** and click on the appropriate application.
- Note: You may begin the process and return to complete the application at another time.

To finish the application process:

- Submit application online.
- The non-refundable application fee of \$30.00 must be paid online (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover credit cards are accepted). If you do not have a credit card please submit payment via check or money order to Purdue University Admissions.
- SAT or ACT scores should be recorded on your high school transcript. If you did not take the SAT's you will not have to take them.
- Mail your official High School transcript to Purdue Admissions in West Lafayette . If you have a GED then you must submit GED information and an official transcript from the school you attended.
