ECET Department Policy on Academic Progression
Effective 1/1/05

It is the policy of the ECET department to assure that all students make positive progress towards an academic degree while at Purdue University. Hence, all ECET students are expected to make progress towards an ECET department degree by taking ECET classes that fulfill degree requirements each semester.

The ECET department also recognizes that occasionally students enrolled in the ECET department programs may determine that their academic interests lay elsewhere. It is the policy of the ECET department to support such students for up to 2 semesters while they become enrolled in other departments. After 2 semesters of such support, the students must either transfer to other departments or resume their ECET studies in a full-time manner to make progress toward an EET degree.
